

## **Data protection information for face-to-face events**

The protection of personal data is important to us. We therefore process your data in accordance with the provisions of the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and other applicable legislation on the protection of personal data and data security.

The following information applies to our face-to-face events. It gives you an overview of what personal data we collect from you, for what purposes and how we use it. We also inform you about the rights you have in relation to your personal data.

### **3. Processed data and its origin**

The categories of personal data processed by us for the registration and organisation of face-to-face events include for example

- Contact information, such as first and last name, e-mail address
- Details of professional activity, e.g. company
- Participation information e.g. days of participation
- Questions and further content from your interactions during the event

**Please note that photographs and video recordings are made at our events. Please refer to the information on photo and video recordings displayed at the event for the exact scope and use of these recordings.**

### **4. Purposes and legal bases of processing**

If you register for an event offered by us, we process your personal data for the purpose of organising the event. The legal basis for this is the fulfilment of a contract, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b) GDPR.

If interested parties agree to be included in our CRM system, this is done on the basis of consent in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a) GDPR.

#### **5. Recipient of the data**

We organise our face-to-face events with various service providers. These service providers are contractually obliged to process your data only in accordance with our instructions and to comply with the applicable data protection regulations.

#### **6. Transfer of data to a country**

The processing of your personal data generally takes place in a member state of the European Union or in another state party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area.

#### **7. Duration of data storage**

We delete your personal data as soon as it is no longer required to fulfil the above-mentioned purposes, unless statutory retention periods prevent deletion. The legal obligations to provide evidence and retain data, which are regulated in the German Commercial Code and the German Fiscal Code, among others, are up to ten years.

#### **8. YOUR**

You have the right to information about the personal data we have stored about you (Art. 15 GDPR). In addition, you can request the rectification/completion (Art. 16 GDPR) or erasure (Art. 17 GDPR) of your data or the restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR). In certain cases, you may request to receive the data you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format or to have this data transmitted to a third party (Art. 20 GDPR). You also have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR).

If we process your data on the basis of your consent, you can revoke this consent at any time without giving reasons with effect for the future (Art. 7 para. 3 GDPR).
